PROPOSED AMENDMENTS 2022/23

Proposed by The Executive Board

1: **New Rule 6A.10:**

In Divisional Singles and Divisional Doubles Tournament play all players **MUST** be in the same Division that is being played.

2: **Change Rule 6A.7 From:**

Each division will have their own division team tournament in their “own division of play”. Teams will only play other teams in the divisions that they play in (example 2nd Division A and 2nd Division B play in the 2nd Division). Rule 5.9 will be followed for division team tournament. A team with only three (3) players may compete and play at the regular season playing nights, as well as tournament and trophy events and will score as follows. When a team has only three (3) players, a zero (0) is to be entered on the scoreboard each time the fourth (4th) player’s turn occurs. If his turn has passed, he must wait till the next game. In tournament or trophy play one (1) player may be picked from another team of the same division or lower; if a team has only three (3) players. League rule (See Rule 6.A.8) does not allow for any pick-ups for the division team tournament.

Change Rule 6A.7 To:

Each division will have their own division team tournament in their “own division of play”. Teams will only play other teams in the divisions that they play in (example 2nd Division A and 2nd Division B play in the 2nd Division). Rule 5.9 will be followed for division team tournament. A team with only three (3) players may compete and play at the regular season playing nights, as well as tournament and trophy events and will score as follows. When a team has only three (3) players, a zero (0) is to be entered on the scoreboard each time the fourth (4th) player’s turn occurs. If his turn has passed, he must wait till the next game.

3: **Change Rule 5 To:**

All League team play shall commence on Thursday Night at 7:30 p.m. If a team with a minimum of three (3) players does not show up at the proper starting time, play commencement may be delayed no later than 7:45 p.m. If a team with a minimum of three (3) players has not shown up by 7:45 p.m. the points for the night may be claimed at the discretion of the offended team. No League games shall be scheduled when the night of play coincides with November 11th, Remembrance Day. All League Thursday tournaments will start at 7:30pm (7:45pm). The Executive has the right to hold tournaments on a Saturday to promote the League.

4: **New Rule 6.15:**

No throwing of ANY additional darts at or towards the board after a player has busted or missed their intended number. Also known as "angry darts".

Discipline for these are as follows :

Singles & Doubles - offending player(s) forfeit that leg.

Team play - offending player receives a zero score.

5: **New Rule 8.6:**

The final week of singles play will be a playoff format whereby the top players will play the bottom (ie. 1st plays 10th, 2nd play 9th, etc). The winner of the playoff would receive a trophy for their specific singles division.

6: **Change Intermediate Singles Division Format From:**

Intermediate Format: Eight (8) games of 501 single in, double out; six (6) games of 301 double in, double out; four (4) games of cricket- total of 18 games.

Change Intermediate Singles Division Format To:

Intermediate Format: Two (2) games of cricket, Eight (8) games of 501 single in, double out; eight (8) games of 301 double in, double out; - total of 18 games.

8: **New Rule 8.2.4:**

Any player that has more than three (3) make-up nights outstanding to play at any time during the season without approval from the Executive Board will be removed from the singles league and will not be permitted to play in the next season.

8: **New Rule 8.7:**

A player that drops or is removed from the singles league may be replaced by a new player if the replacement takes place within the first four (4) weeks of league play. All games and stats prior to the replacement player being added will be nulled for the replacement player but games won/lost will remain intact for the players that had played the person prior. If the four week grace period has passed, all stats for anyone that has already played that player will remain intact. Any players that still needed to play that player will now be classified as a bye week with an automatic 2 points awarded and only the required number of games added that would allow for the win (ie. 24 game formats would be awarded 2 points and 13 wins).

8: **New Rule 8.8:**

The final 3 weeks of singles play will be playoffs for only the top 8 in each of the singles divisions. 1 match per week, Week 1 is quarterfinals (1 vs 8, 2vs7, 3vs6, 4vs5), Week 2 is semifinals, and Week 3 is the finals. 1 extra game of 501 would be added to each format to ensure no ties are possible. Dead legs do not need to be played.
