



## *SCORE KEEPER'S 11 COMMANDMENTS*

- 1) THOU SHALL NOT TALK WHILE KEEPING SCORE
- 2) THOU SHALL NOT MOVE ABOUT - STAND STILL
- 3) THOU SHALL NOT LOOK AT THE SHOOTER - STAND FACING THE BOARD
- 4) THOU SHALL NOT CALL OUT SCORE OF DARTS UNLESS ASKED
- 5) THOU SHALL NOT TELL A SHOOTER WHAT COMBINATION TO SHOOT FOR AN OUT
- 6) THOU SHALL NOT CHANGE A SCORE IF A PLAYER HAS SHOT AGAIN AND A SECOND SCORE IS WRITTEN DOWN
- 7) THOU SHALL NOT LEAN OUT TO SEE WHERE A DART IS, OR FOLLOW A DART WITH BODY OR HEAD MOVEMENTS
- 8) THOU SHALL NOT SHOW ANY SIGNS OF DISGUST OR EXCITEMENT WHILE SCORING
- 9) THOU SHALL NOT CHANGE THE SIDES OF THE SCORE BOARDS OF PLAYERS, IN 3 LEG MATCHES, IF YOU START A TEAM ON THE LEFT, LEAVE THEM ON THE LEFT
- 10) THOU SHALL NOT TELL A SHOOTER WHAT TO SHOOT
- 11) THOU SHALL NOT ERASE THE LAST TWO SCORES OFF THE BOARD OF BOTH TEAMS

**The method of scoring shall be by subtraction.**

**Each players score shall be prominently shown on a scoreboard and deducted to show the score remaining.**

**When the remaining score is one hundred and seventy (170) or less, the scorekeeper will commence to draw a line through the last score recorded and the previous remaining score.**

**The preferred method of chalking will be left to right (score, total, score and total) for all regular and tournament games in the LDMDL.**
