

<u>Past AGM Minutes:</u> The minutes from the May 25, 2023 AGM are presented & read by the membership at the meeting. Motion to accept the May 25, 2023 minutes is made by the President, seconded by Anthony Scanlan. Carried unanimously.

<u>Presidents Letter:</u> The Presidents letter was given out to the membership & the President reads it aloud. The President reports that due to lower than expected attendance at the annual banquet there was a surplus of funds & these funds were allocated in the following manner. 1. The upcoming season registration fee was reduced. 2. A new league website was built & will be operational for the upcoming season. 3. <u>Treasurers Report:</u> The Treasurer now reads his report aloud to the membership. <u>Honorariums:</u> The chair now adresses the Rule 11.3 that deals with the monies that the Executive are paid for their honorariums. The chair asks for a member to make a motion. Brian Harris motions to include London Homeless Veterans. Ed Lewanick motions to include Bubz soup kitchen. London Youth League is included by the Exceutive as a whole. Ray Daamen seconded these motions.

Ben Garner motions to have the charity donations topped up to \$2000.00, seconded by Terry Pettigrew, voted 27 for, 1 against.

Mark Ticehurst motions to give each charity \$500.00, seconded by Ray Daamen, unanimously passed.

Amendments: The Secretary starts a discussion regarding rule amandments.

- 1. Add new rule 6A.10 Divisional singles & doubles, all players must be in the same division that is being played. Seconded by Terry Pettigrew, voted 27 for, 1 against.
- 2. Change rule 6A.7. Seconed by Jeff Smith, voted 28 for, 0 against
- 3. Change rule 5 Seconded by Ray Daamen, voted 2 for, 26 against.
- 4. Add new rule 6.15 Seconded by Robin Boocock, voted 1 for, 27 against
- 5. Add new rule final week of singles will be a playoff format. Seconded by Terry Pettigrew. Jeff Smith has withdrawn his amendment.
- 6. Rule to reduce amount of games in Cricket & inrease the number of games in 301, seconded by Ray Daamen, voted 28 for, 0 against.
- 7. Change format in 4th Division. Only 5 members are present so they can be the only ones who vote. Seconded by Ray Daamen, voted 5 for, 0 against
- 8. New Rule added by Ben Garner regarding forefits. More than 3 forefits, player will be removed & unable to play the next season. Seconded by Mark Ticehurst, voted 27 for, 1 against.
- 9. New Rule added by Ben Garner, only allowing replacement players in singles upto week 4 of schedule. Seconded by Dan Riley, voted 25 for, 3 against.

<u>Discussion from the Floor:</u> Mark Ticehurst starts a discussion regarding keeping the Premier Singles Division at 8 players. Secretary adressed that the rule is in place & will stay until a future amendment is proposed & voted on by the members.

Dan Riley started a discussion regarding the Secretary resignation. Wants to know how the position will be filled. The President responded with the Executive will meet the next week to discuss how the position will be filled

Andrew Ferguson started a discussion reminding the members of the upcoming dates for the 2023-2024 season. Team & Singles registration will be held Thurs Aug 3,2023 and the 1st night
