Proposed Amendments 2025/2026

1. <u>Change to rule 10.6A from</u>: Any League member that has been found guilty of violating the League rulebook and receives disciplinary action against him according to Rule 10.6 <u>MUST</u> receive a written letter from the League Secretary showing what rule(s) and what disciplinary action the member has received from the Executive Board.

<u>Change to:</u> Any league member that has been found guilty of violating the League rullebook and recieves disciplinary action against him according to rule 10.6 will recieve a letter from the League Secretary. The form letter will identify the member, the date of expulsion and reinstatement, the rule violated and date of violation.

2. <u>Change to rule 10.6 B</u> The League Secretary <u>MUST</u> deliver the disciplinary letter by **whichever means are convenient** within two (2) weeks from the date of the Executive Meeting (regular or special) that the member was found guilty of violating the rulebook. If the offending member or his team Captain does not receive the disciplinary letter within two (2) weeks, the member will have the offense removed from league records and will be noted in the next regular Executive Meeting minutes.

<u>Change to:</u> The league secretary will fill out a form disciplinary letter at the Executive meeting (regular or special) that the member was found guilty of violating the rulebook and give that letter to the member at that same meeting. The offending member's team Captain will be notified of the disciplinary action taken by the Excecutive, by whichever means is convenient.
